The record is put up today on the prayer of the plaintiffs.

“No caveat” has been lodged as it appears from the report by the sheristader till 02:00 P.M.

Ld. Advocate for the plaintiffs has moved the prayer for ad-interim injunction.

The case of the plaintiffs in nutshell is that the plaintiffs are the owners of the suit property. The principal defendants have been threatening to dispossess the plaintiffs from the suit property.

The plaintiffs filed photocopies of documents by way of firisti.

On perusal of documents filed by the plaintiffs it prima facie appears that the plaintiffs are the owners of the suit property.

Considering the above circumstances this Court is of the opinion that the plaintiffs have made out a prima facie case. The balance of convenience and inconvenience is also in favour of the plaintiffs. The purpose of granting injunction may be defeated by delay due to the service of notice and the plaintiffs are likely to suffer irreparable loss.

Hence, it is,

ORDERED

that the prayer for ad-interim injunction is allowed.

Both the plaintiffs and the principal defendants are directed to maintain status-quo in respect of the nature, character and possession of the suit schedule property till **20.08.2026**.

Issue notice to the defendants.

Plaintiffs to comply with the provisions under Order 39 Rule 3 (a) and (b) of C.P.C. at once.
