I know the complainant of this case namely, Soma Bala Das as she is my daughter. I also know the accused persons namely, Raju Das, Rajib Das & Subrajit Das as they are from my locality.

The accused persons are absent today and witness claims that he can identify them by face and name.

The incident occurred on 24/12/2023, at about 10:30 pm, at the house of my daughter, located at Netaji Nagar, Kulai. At that night, Raju Das, Rajib Das & Subrajit Das came to the house of my daughter. At that time, I was present inside her home. Three of them entered into the house, while being under heavy intoxication. They assaulted my grand sons namely Bishal Debnath (22 years old) – and Bikram Debnath (19 years old) with fists, blows and ‘dandas’ (wood sticks). Hearing the hue and cry of my grandsons, I myself and my daughter and my son in law came out to protect my grand sons. When my daughter and my son in law tried to save my grandsons, the accused persons assaulted both of them also with those ‘dandas’. They also threatened me and pushed me on the ground. Later on Raju Das, Rajib Das & Subrajit Das lodged a false case against my grandsons. The police came and took them to the police station.

Cross-examination

It is a fact that the Investigating Officer inquired me in connection with this case.

It is a fact that I stated to the Investigating Officer that - **three of them entered into the house, while being under heavy intoxication; they assaulted my grand sons namely Bishal Debnath (22 years old) – and**

Bikram Debnath (19 years old) with fists, blows and ‘dandas’ (wood sticks).
