

 MHCO010002182026	<u>Dispute No. CCIV/244/2026</u> <u>Shivmurat Kushwah and Ors Vs. Om Sidhraj CHSL LTD</u> ORDER BELOW EXHIBIT 05
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This is an application filed by Disputant to seek Ex-party ad-interim relief with regards to special general body meeting (SGBM) dated 28th June 2026 to be conducted by opponents.

2. It seems appropriate to mention here that the said notice was given on 11.06.2026. The Disputant argued that they approached to the Registrar and Informed him. It is to be noted that he had two weeks' time to file this dispute in this court. Despite of that he fails to do so. Additionally, he has not provided any explanation as to why he has remained silent from 11.06.2026 until now. Furthermore, if the Disputant was in such a hurry, then why he did not give the notice to the opponents before filing the claim.

3. Also, considering the nature of the proposed meeting, the concerned member will be given an opportunity to raise objections. Therefore, I do not find any reason to grant Ex-party ad interim. For all these reasons, it would be proper to issue a show cause notice to the opponent as to why injunction should not be granted without hearing the opponent. Issue show cause Notice to the opponents Returnable on 29.06.2026. Hence, I pass following order:

ORDER

01. Issue show cause Notice to the opponent
