**Petition dated: 26.02.2026 u/s 483 of BNSS praying to enlarge the petitioner on bail**

This petition coming on this day for hearing before me having the petition filed by the petitioners Counsel M/s R. Loganathan, S. Poovarasam, A. Inbatamizhan, N. Manikandan, V. Dineshkumar, the respondent police through the Public Prosecutor, and upon hearing the arguments of both sides, perusing the reply of the Public Prosecutor for the State/Respondent and perusing the records and material and hearing both sides, this court made the following:-

**ORDER**

Heard arguments of both side. Records perused. Petition filed u/s 483 of BNSS seeking to release the petitioner who was remanded on 07.02.2026 in Crime No. 26/2026 on the file of Ponneri police station registered for the offence u/s 103(1), 238, 351(2) of BNS.

The learned counsel for the petitioner argued that, petitioner is innocent, she has been falsely implicated only on suspicion, she has been arrested, there was no motive , only since the husband of the deceased is having intimacy with the petitioner, she has been dragged into this case, the petitioner was not at all present in the place of occurrence, the petitioner who was at the time of alleged occurrence was attending her examination as she is the student of Bharathi Womens College, she has been falsely implicated in this case, the petitioner has to attend her semester examination, only since the petitioner had friendship with the A1, only on suspicion she has been arrested, she is in custody for the past 31 days, this is the 2<sup>nd</sup> bail petition, petitioner is ready to cooperate for investigation and will abide by any condition, therefore prayed for granting the bail.

Notice given to concerned police and reply received. The learned Public prosecutor argued that the defacto complainant is the mother of the deceased she lodged a complaint stating that 14.12.2025, the defacto complainant's son in law on 06.02.2026 called her and informed that her daughter was severely injured in his house, when the defacto complainant and her husband rushed to the house of accused found that their daughter was found injured over her face, an head and found dead, based on the complaint, FIR was registered u/s 103(1), 238, 351(2), 61(2) of BNS and during the course of investigation found that A1, who is the husband of the deceased, pressed the pillow over the face of the deceased and committed murder , and also forcibly hit her head on the TV, thus, the deceased died, petitioner who is the sister in law of A1 was arrested on 07.02.2026 and the investigation is pending.

The petitioner states in this petition that there is no similar bail petition is pending before any other Court including Hon'ble High Court, Madras and the respondent has also not stated as to pending of any bail petition before Hon'ble High Court, Madras in this case. Hence, this Court considers that there is no impediment to entertain this petition and pass orders on merits.

As per the reply of the learned Public Prosecutor, investigation is pending in preliminary stage and the alleged offence is serious in nature.

Therefore, on considering

- (i) grave nature of offence
- (ii) investigation is pending
- (iii) premature stage,
- (iv) serious accusation of offence as against the petitioner u/s 103 (1) BNS
- (v) there is no change in circumstances,
- (v) and also considering other facts and circumstances,

this Court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

**In the result, this petition is dismissed.**
