**Petition dated: 03.03.2026 u/s 483 of BNSS praying to enlarge the petitioner on bail**

This petition coming on this day for hearing before me having the petition filed by the petitioners Counsel M/s A. Kumaran, G. Gokul, V. Ganeshkumar, the respondent police through the Public Prosecutor, and upon hearing the arguments of both sides, perusing the reply of the Public Prosecutor for the State/Respondent and perusing the records and material and hearing both sides, this court made the following:-

**ORDER**

Both side arguments. Records perused. Petition filed u/s 483(1) of BNSS seeking modification in the bail condition imposed by this Court in CMP No. 607/2026 dated 20.02.2026.

The petitioner who was remanded on 24.12.2025 was granted bail by this Court in CMP No. 607/2026 dated 20.02.2026 concerned with Crime No.579/2025 of Pattabiram Police station registered for the offence u/s 126(2), 296(b), 115(2), 309(4), 311, 361(3) of BNS with the condition to sign before the Thiruvottiyur police station daily at 10.00 AM for 30 days.

It is contended by the learned counsel for the petitioner, petitioner is a daily wager and he is residing at Soranjeri and he could not travel from his residence to Thiruvottiyur for 45 kilometer daily due to which his livelihood and job is at stake, , prayed to modify the bail condition permitting her to sign before the respondent police station.

Notice given to concerned police and the learned Public prosecutor has submitted that the petitioner has not complied the condition so far and the petition may be considered on merits.

As per the reply of the Public Prosecutor , the investigation is still pending. The petitioner has not complied the conditions. Petitioner states that she is daily wager and could not travel to Thiruvottiyur daily to comply the conditions. He is ready to comply the conditions before the respondent police. Hence, considering the plea of the petitioner and also the fact that the investigation is pending and the petitioner has not complied the conditions so far even for a single day, this Court is inclined to modify the bail conditions as follows.

In the result, this petition is partly allowed and the bail conditions imposed by this Court in CMP No. 607/2026 dated 20.02.2026 sign before the Thiruvottiyur Police station daily at 10.00 AM for 30 days is hereby modified to the effect that the petitioner shall appear and sign before the Thiruvottiyur Police station daily at 10.00 AM for a period of 10 days and thereafter, before the respondent police ( Pattabiram Police station) daily at 10.00 AM for the remaining days with all other conditions therein remain unchanged.
