Petition dated: 05.03.2026 u/s 483 of B.N.S.S., praying to enlarge the Petitioner on bail

This petition coming on this day for hearing before me having the petition filed by the petitioners Counsel M/s A. ThamaraiKannan, M.G. Muthusamy, G. Kothandaraman, and the respondent police through the Public Prosecutor and hearing the arguments of both sides, perusing the reply of the Public Prosecutor for the State/Respondent and perusing the records and material and hearing both sides, this court made the following:-

ORDER

Heard arguments of both side. Records perused. Petition filed u/s 483 of BNSS seeking to release the petitioner who was remanded on 28.02.2026 in Crime No.239/2025 on the file of Kanakammachatram police station registered for the offence u/s 309(4), 311 of BNS

The learned counsel for the petitioner argued that, petitioner is innocent, he has been falsely implicated only for statistical purpose, the petitioner was not at all present in the place of occurrence, the respondent police falsely implicated only since the petitioner belongs to a nearby area, there is no previous cases pending as against the petitioner, petitioner is an unnamed accused in the FIR, only suspicion , he has been arrested based on the confession of co-accused, property already recovered, he is in custody for the past 27 days, petitioner is ready to cooperate for investigation and will abide by any condition, therefore prayed for granting the bail.

Notice given to concerned police and reply received. The learned Public prosecutor argued that on 31.12.2025 at about 1.50 PM, when the defacto complainant was coming in his two wheeler bearing Reg.No. TN12AA4432 near Lakashmapuram keeping totally Rs.17,25,000/- which was given by his owner TRS Enterprises, from Tiruttani to Tiruvallur, near the petitioner along with another accused came in bike and waylaid and demanded money, for which when he refused the petitioner assaulted him with knife and robbed Rs.17,25,000/- at knife point and escaped, based on the complaint, FIR was registered, the petitioner was arrested on 28.02.2026 , the money is not recovered, petitioner is having one previous case and the investigation is pending.

The petitioner states in this petition that there is no similar bail petition is pending before any other Court including Hon'ble High Court, Madras and the respondent has also not stated as to pending of any bail petition before Hon'ble High Court, Madras in this case. Hence, this Court considers that there is no impediment to entertain this petition and pass orders on merits.

As per the reply of the learned Public Prosecutor, investigation is still pending and the alleged amount involved is not recovered and the petitioner is having a previous case.

Therefore, on considering

- (i) grave nature of offence
- (ii) investigation is still pending
- (iii) huge value of the amount allegedly involved, which is not yet recovered,
- (iv) serious accusation of offence as against the petitioner u/s 311 BNS
- (v) that the representation of the learned Public Prosecutor that since the petitioner is having a previous case, if he is released and then absconds, investigation in both the cases as against him would also be affected,
- (v) and also considering other facts and circumstances,
this Court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

In the result, this petition is dismissed.
