**Petition dated: 07.03.2026 u/s 482 of B.N.S.S., praying to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners**

This petition coming on this day for hearing before me having the petition filed by the petitioners Counsel M/s M. Jothiramalingam, R. Loganathan, G. Selvakumar, S. Poovarasam, A. Inbatamizhan, M. Manikandan, V. Dineshkumar, and the respondent police through the Public Prosecutor and upon hearing the arguments of both sides, perusing the reply of the Public Prosecutor for the State/Respondent and perusing the records and material and hearing both sides, this court made the following:-

**ORDER**

Heard arguments of both side. Records perused. Petition filed u/s 482 of BNSS seeking to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners who apprehend arrest in Crime No.47/2026 of Pathirivedu police station for the offence u/s 296(b), 126(1), 115(1), 329(2), 351(3) of BNS r/w 4 of TNPWH Act.

The learned counsel for the petitioner argued that, the petitioners are innocents and they are in no way connected with the alleged offence only due to some wordy quarrel in the place of occurrence due to the land dispute and issuance of patta, only since the petitioners asked the defacto complainant's husband about the patta and insisted for speedy process, she had lodged a false complaint, there is no injury to anyone, the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> petitioners are ladies, petitioners have no antecedents, ready to cooperate for investigation and will abide by any condition, therefore prayed for granting the anticipatory bail.

Notice given to concerned police and reply received. The learned Public prosecutor argued that the defacto complainant's husband is working as village Assistant in Kannankottai Village, the petitioners belong to the same village and they applied for patta for their lands, since there was some delay in issuance of patta, they construed that the defacto complainant's husband is the reason for the delay, and due to such enmity, on 01.03.2026 at about 9.00 PM, when the defacto complainant and her husband were coming near a play ground, they abused the defacto complainant and assaulted them with hands and they trespassed into the house of defacto complainant and threatened to kill their children, the defacto complainant's husband sustained minor injuries and treated as outpatient, based on the complaint, FIR was registered and the investigation is pending.

The petitioner states in this petition that there is no similar bail petition is pending before any other Court including Hon'ble High Court, Madras and the respondent has also not stated as to pending of any bail petition before Hon'ble High Court, Madras in this case. Hence, this Court considers that there is no impediment to entertain this petition and pass orders on merits.

As per the reply of the learned Public Prosecutor, investigation is pending in preliminary stage and the alleged offence is serious in nature.

Therefore, on considering

- (i) grave nature of offence which is against a woman,
  - (ii) investigation is pending
  - (iii) premature stage,
  - (iv) serious accusation of offence as against the petitioners
  - (v) and also considering other facts and circumstances,
- this Court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioners.

**In the result, this petition is dismissed.**
