Petition dated: 01.06.2026 u/s 483 of BNSS praying to enlarge the petitioner on bail

This petition coming on this day for hearing before me having the petition filed by the petitioners Counsel M/s S. Munivelu, S. Praveen, M. Bharathwarj, the respondent police through the Public Prosecutor, and upon hearing the arguments of both sides, perusing the reply of the Public Prosecutor for the State/Respondent and perusing the records and material and hearing both sides, this court made the following:-

ORDER

Heard arguments of both side. Records perused. Petition filed u/s 483 of BNSS seeking to release the petitioner who were remanded on 11.02.2026 in Crime No. 105/2026 on the file of Puzhal police station registered for the offence u/s 310(2), 311 of BNS @ 310(2), 311, 61(2) of BNS

The learned counsel for the petitioner argued that, petitioner is innocent, they have falsely implicated only for statistical purpose, the petitioners were not at all present in the place of occurrence, coaccused were already granted bail, charge sheet has already been filed, hence, further incarceration is not necessary, petitioners are unnamed accused in the FIR, only suspicion, properties were already recovered, they have been arrested he is in custody for the 120 days they are ready to cooperate for committal and trial proceedings, will abide by any condition, therefore prayed for granting the bail.

Notice given to concerned police and reply received. The learned Public prosecutor argued that on 11.02.2026 at about 5.45 AM, when the defacto complainant was in his house, the petitioners along with other accused trespassed into the house and tied the defacto complainant and robbed Rs.25,00,000/- , 13 sovereign gold and 250 grams of silver at knife point and escaped, based on the complaint, FIR was registered the petitioner were arrested on 11.02.2026, only 3.5 lakhs and 8 sovereign gold were recovered, the 1st petitioner is having 4 previous cases, 2nd petitioner is having 5 previous cases and the 3rd petitioner is having 5 previous cases, charge sheet has been filed.

The petitioners state in this petition that there is no similar bail petition is pending before any other Court including Hon'ble High Court, Madras and the respondent has also not stated as to pending of any bail petition before Hon'ble High Court, Madras in this case. Hence, this Court considers that there is no impediment to entertain this petition and pass orders on merits.

As per the reply of the learned Public Prosecutor, the petitioners are having criminal antecedents and the alleged properties involved are huge valued out of which only part of the properties recovered . Though charge sheet is filed, it is in preliminary stage.

Therefore, on considering

- (i) Grave nature of offence,
 - (ii) Serious accusation of offence u/s 311 of BNS,
 - (iii) Huge value of the properties allegedly involved, which are not yet fully recovered,
 - (iv) that the representation of the learned Public Prosecutor that since the petitioners are having previous cases, if they are released and then abscond, investigation all the cases against them and proceedings in this case would be affected,
 - (v) And also considering other facts and circumstances
- this Court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner

In the result, this petition is dismissed.
