Petition dated: 01/06/2026 u/s 482(1) BNSS praying for extension of time to surrender

This petition coming on this day for hearing before me having the petition filed by the petitioner Counsel M/s.D.Lemuvel, C.Murugan, R.Hariharan and the respondent police through the Public Prosecutor and hearing the arguments of both sides, perusing the reply of the Public Prosecutor for the State/Respondent and perusing the records and material and hearing both sides, this court made the following:-

ORDER

Heard arguments of both side. Records perused. Petition filed u/s 482(1) BNSS seeking extension of time to surrender before the concerned Court as per the orders of this Court in Crl.M.P.No. 959/2026 dated 23.03.2026.

The petitioner was granted anticipatory bail by this Court in Crl.M.P.No. 959/2026 dated 23.03.2026 in Crime No. 351/2026 of Vengal Police station for the offences u/s 296(b), 118(1), 351(3) of BNS with the condition to surrender before the Judicial Magistrate No I Tiruvallur within 15 days and thereafter to sign before the respondent police daily 10.00 AM and for 30 days.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that, the petitioner is not feeling well, she could not able to mobilize the sureties within the stipulated time hence, she could not surrender before the concern court, hence prayed for extension of time for surrender.

Notice given to concerned police and the learned Public Prosecutor has stated may consider on merits to this petition.

The petitioner states that the petitioner is not feeling well, she could not appear and surrender as per the order. The learned Public Prosecutor has also stated no objection to this petition for granting extension of time for surrender. Therefore, on considering the above facts and circumstances and plea of petitioner, as the learned Public Prosecutor has no objection to this petition, this Court is inclined to allow this petition.

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In the result, this petition is allowed and 7 days time is granted from today to the petitioner. The petitioner shall surrender before the Judicial Magistrate No I Tiruvallur on or before 15.06.2026 with all other conditions imposed by this Court in CrI.M.P.No. 959/2026 dated 23.03.2026 remains unchanged.
