This petition coming on this day for hearing before me having the petition filed by the petitioners Counsel M/s B. Thomson Durai, V. Vignesh, Vijayakrishnan, the respondent police through the Public Prosecutor, and the State / respondent police represented by the learned Public Prosecutor Thiru. N.R. Sreedharan Babu and upon hearing the arguments of both sides, perusing the reply of the Public Prosecutor for the State/Respondent and perusing the records and material and hearing both sides, this court made the following:-

ORDER

Heard learned Public Prosecutor and Records perused. Petition filed u/s 483(1) of BNSS seeking relaxation of the bail condition imposed by this Court in CMP No.2175/2026 dt. 22.06.2026.

The petitioner who was remanded on 11.05.2026 in Crime No.142/2026 was granted bail by this Court on 22.06.2026 in Crime No.142/2026 on the file of Vengal police station registered for the offence u/s 296(b), 115(2), 109, 351(3) of BNS. with the condition to sign before the respondent police station daily at 10.00 AM for 30 days.

There is no representation for the petitioner for the past 3 hearings. Hence, orders passed on merits.

Notice given to concerned police and the learned Public prosecutor has submitted that the petitioner has so far complied the conditions 23 days.

Since there is no representation for the petitioner, this Court could not ascertain with the petitioner is cooperating for the investigating and will further comply the conditions as per the orders dated 22.06.2026 . In the above said circumstances, this petition seeking relaxation of condition cannot be considered.

In the result, this petition is dismissed.
