Petition dated: 10.07.2026 u/s 482 of BNSS praying to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner

This petition coming on this day for hearing before me having the petition filed by the petitioner Counsel M/s K. Sudhankumar, M. Irulamurthy, and the State/ respondent police represented by Thiru.N.R. Sreedharan Babu, the Public Prosecutor, and upon hearing the arguments of both sides, perusing the reply of the Public Prosecutor for the State/Respondent and perusing the records and material and hearing both sides, this court made the following:-

ORDER

Heard arguments of both side. Records perused. Petition filed u/s 48 of BNSS seeking to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner apprehends arrest in in Crime No.201/2025 on the file of Tiruvallur Taluk police station registered for the offence u/s 132(1), 351(3) of BNS @ 121(1), 109(3) of BNS.

The learned counsel for the petitioner argued that, petitioner is innocent, he has been falsely implicated only for statistical purpose only due to some previous cases, only based on the confession of the co-accused he has been falsely implicated, the petitioner was not at all present in the place of occurrence, he has been arrested only through PT Warrant on 06.03.2026, but he was not remanded by the Judicial Magistrate No.I, Tiruvallur, this case is of the year 2025, investigation is completed, petitioner is ready to cooperate for investigation and will abide by any condition, therefore prayed for granting the anticipatory bail.

Notice given to concerned police and reply received. The learned Public prosecutor argued that on 26.06.2025 when the defacto complainant Sub Inspector was searching the petitioner in connection with NDPS Case, , based on the discreet information, at about 2.30 PM when the defacto complainant was conducting surveillance near Tirupachur junction, the petitioner who was having 20 previous cases and , an accused in search for arrest in Crime No.144/2026 of Jam Bazaar police station, the petitioner was coming in a car bearing Reg.no. TN0 6AD0391 when the defacto complainant tried to arrest him, he assaulted the defacto complainant with iron rod, causing minor injuries, and fled the spot, based on the complaint, FIR was registered u/s 132, 351(3) of BNS and altered to 121(1), 109 of BNS, the petitioner is having 20 previous cases and the investigation is pending.

The petitioner states in this petition that there is no similar bail petition is pending before any other Court including Hon'ble High Court, Madras and the respondent has also not stated as to pending of any bail petition before Hon'ble High Court, Madras in this case. Hence, this Court considers that there is no impediment to entertain this petition and pass orders on merits.

As per the reply of the learned Public Prosecutor, investigation is still pending and the alleged offence is serious in nature, and the petitioner is having criminal antecedents with 20 previous cases

Therefore, on considering

- (i) grave nature of offence
- (ii) investigation is still pending
- (iii) serious accusation of offence as against the petitioner u/s 109 of BNS
- (iv) that the representation of the learned Public Prosecutor that since the petitioner is having 20 previous cases, if he is granted anticipatory bail and then absconds, investigation in all the cases as against him would also be affected
- (v) there is no change in circumstances,
- (vi) and also considering other facts and circumstances,

this Court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

In the result, this petition is dismissed.
