Petition dated: 15.07.2026 u/s 483 of BNSS praying to enlarge the petitioner on bail

This petition coming on this day for hearing before me having the petition filed by the petitioners Counsel M/s K. Sudarsanan, S. Dinesh and the State / respondent police represented by the learned Public Prosecutor Thiru.N.R. Sreedharan Babu and upon hearing the arguments of both sides, perusing the reply of the Public Prosecutor for the State/Respondent and perusing the records and material and hearing both sides, this court made the following:-

ORDER

Heard arguments of both side. Records perused. Petition filed u/s 483 of BNSS seeking to release the petitioners who was remanded on 13.07.2026 in Crime No. 281/2026 on the file of Manali police station registered for the offence u/s 296(b), 109(1), 351(3), 61(2), 3(5) of BNS.

The learned counsel for the petitioner argued that, petitioner is innocent, he has been falsely implicated only due to previous enmity, the petitioner and the defacto complainant and known persons, there was only wordy quarrel between the other accused and the defacto complainant, the petitioner who is only a friend of co-accused has been falsely implicated only based on the confession of other accused, co-accused were already granted bail by this Court in CMP No. 2676/2026 dated 15.07.2026, the injured is already discharged, petitioner has no bad antecedents, investigation completed, the he is in custody for 8 days, he is ready to cooperate for investigation and will abide by any condition, therefore prayed for granting the bail.

Notice given to concerned police and reply received. The learned Public prosecutor argued that there was enmity existed between the defacto complainant and the accused due to the matrimonial dispute between one of the accused and his wife, for which they construed that the defacto complainant is the reason, and they planned to commit murder of the defacto complainant and conspired for the same, subsequently 10.06.2026 at about 7.00 AM, when the defacto complainant along with his friend were coming in Kodungaiyur Jaibalaji 2nd street, petitioner along with other accused waylaid him and assaulted him with cricket stump, , both sustained injuries, admitted in hospital and later discharged, based on the complaint, FIR was registered, the other accused were arrested on 16.06.2026, the petitioner was arrested on 13.07.2026, and the investigation is pending.

The petitioner states in this petition that there is no similar bail petition is pending before any other Court including Hon'ble High Court, Madras and the respondent has also not stated as to pending of any bail petition before Hon'ble High Court, Madras in this case. Hence, this Court considers that there is no impediment to entertain this petition and pass orders on merits.

As per the reply of the learned Public Prosecutor, the investigation is still pending . Even though the co-accused were released the investigation in respect of the petitioner is pending in preliminary stage as he is in custody only for 8 days.

Therefore, on considering

- (i) Grave nature of offence,
- (ii) Investigation is still pending,
- (iii) Premature stage as far as the investigation in respect of the petitioner is concerned,
- (iv) Serious accusation of offence u/s 109(1) of BNS,
- (v) And also considering other facts and circumstances

this Court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner

In the result, this petition is dismissed.
