Petition dated: 15.07.2026 u/s 483 of BNSS praying to enlarge the petitioners on bail

This petition coming on this day for hearing before me having the petition filed by the petitioners Counsel M/s K.V. Dilipkumar, U. Ashok Kumar, V. Nirmal Raj, G. Tharun, and the State/respondent police represented by Thiru.N.R. Sreedharan Babu, the Public Prosecutor, and upon hearing the arguments of both sides, perusing the reply of the Public Prosecutor for the State/Respondent and perusing the records and material and hearing both sides, this court made the following:-

ORDER

Heard arguments of both side. Records perused. Petition filed u/s 483 of BNSS seeking to release the petitioner who was remanded on 09.07.2026 in Crime No. 573/2026 on the file of Madhuravoyal police station registered for the offence u/s 296(b), 115(2), 118(1) 109(1) , 351(3) of BNS

The learned counsel for the petitioner argued that, petitioner is innocent, he has been falsely implicated only due to wordy quarrel between them only due to previous enmity, the injured person is already discharged, the petitioner is an UG Degree student, he is in custody for the 16 days in this case, he is ready to cooperate for investigation and will abide by any condition, therefore prayed for granting the bail.

Notice given to concerned police and reply received. The learned Public prosecutor argued that on 08.07.2026 at about 8.30 PM, when the defacto complainant along with his friends were in Mulberry Juice shop situated at Alapakkam at about 8.30 PM, the petitioner along with co-accused came to the shop, and due to previous enmity they had clash against each other, wherein the accused persons assaulted the defacto complainant with knife, the defacto complainant sustained grievous injuries, admitted in hospital and still admitted in hospital, based on the complaint, FIR was registered, the petitioner was arrested on 09.07.2026, the petitioner is having two previous cases and the investigation is pending in preliminary stage,

The petitioner states in this petition that there is no similar bail petition is pending before any other Court including Hon'ble High Court, Madras and the respondent has also not stated as to pending of any bail petition before Hon'ble High Court, Madras in this case. Hence, this Court considers that there is no impediment to entertain this petition and pass orders on merits.

As per the reply of the learned Public Prosecutor, investigation is pending and the petitioner is having 2 previous cases and the injured is still admitted in the hospital.

Therefore, on considering

- (i) Grave of offence
 - (ii) Investigation is pending
 - (iii) Premature stage,
 - (iv) Serious accusation of offence as against the petitioner u/s 109 (1) of BNS.
 - (v) Serious nature of injuries inflicted upon the victim,
 - (vi) That the injured person is still admitted in hospital,
 - (vii) that the representation of the learned Public Prosecutor that since the petitioner is having a previous case, if he is released and then absconds, investigation in both the cases against him would also be affected
 - (viii) And considering other facts and circumstances,
- this Court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner

In the result, this petition is dismissed.
