Petition dated: 15.07.2026 u/s 482 (1) of BNSS praying to modify the bail conditions

This petition coming on this day for hearing before me having the petition filed by the petitioner Counsel M/s M. Abinash, T. Rajaram, S. Saravanan, and the State / respondent police represented by the learned Public Prosecutor Thiru. N.R. Sreedharan Babu and upon hearing the arguments of both sides, perusing the reply of the Public Prosecutor for the State/Respondent and perusing the records and material and hearing both sides, this court made the following:-

ORDER

Both side arguments. Records perused. Petition filed u/s 483(1) of BNSS seeking relaxation in the bail condition imposed by this Court in CMP No. 2326/2026 dated 25.06.2026

The petitioners who were grant anticipatory bail in CMP No.2326/2026 dated 25.06.2026 in Crime No.118/2026 of Uthukkottai Police station for the offences u/s 296(b), 118(1), 351(3) of BNS with the condition to sign before the respondent police daily at 10.00 AM for 30 days.

It is contended by the learned counsel for the petitioners, that they have complied the conditions for the past 15 days, 1st petitioner is a daily wager and 2nd petitioner is a student , and due to compliance of conditions, they could not go to his job and attend his studies properly, hence, prayed to relax the bail condition.

Notice given to concerned police and reply received. The learned Public prosecutor has submitted that the 1st petitioner complied the conditions for 15 days and the 2nd petitioner for 17 days.

Petitioners state that they have complied the conditions for more than 15 and 17 days respectively . As per the reply, the petitioners have complied the conditions for 15 and 17 days respectively. There is no default in compliance of condition. Petitioners further states that due to compliance of conditions, they could not go to job and to attend studies. Hence, considering the plea of the petitioners and also period of compliance, this Court is inclined to modify the bail conditions.

In the result, this petition is partly allowed and the bail conditions imposed by this Court in CMP No.2326/2026 dated 25.06.2026 that the petitioners to appear and sign respondent police daily at 10.00 AM for 30 days is hereby modified to the effect that the petitioners shall appear and sign before the respondent police once, i.e. on every Sunday at 10.00 AM for the remaining days with all other conditions therein remain unchanged.
