**ORDER
(DICTATED IN OPEN COURT)**

1. Perused the application and say filed by the prosecution.
Heard learned Advocate for accused No.13 Vimal Mohanlal Jain and
learned SPP

2. Accused No.13 has filed this application for seeking
permission to travel Coimbatore for business purpose. The Hon'ble High

Court while passing bail order in Bail Application No.2257 of 2024 put condition on accused No.13 that without prior permission of Trial Court, he shall not leave the State of Maharashtra.

3. It is the contention of accused No.13 that he wants to go to Coimbatore for business purpose. In the said application, the accused No.13 is seeking permission to travel to Coimbatore from 13.08.2026 to 17.08.2026 (as per pursis Exh.234-B dated 11.08.2026). For the above reasons, accused No.13 is seeking permission.

4. The prosecution has opposed the said application on the ground that accused No.13 is facing trial for the offences punishable under sections 302, 307, 120-B, 212, 201 r/w. 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, sections 3 and 25 of the Indian Arms Act, 1959, sections 37(1)(A) and 135 of the Maharashtra Police Act and sections 3(1)(i) (ii), 3(2) and 3(4) of the Maharashtra Control of Organized Crime Act, 1999 and therefore, if he is permitted to travel out of Maharashtra State, then there are chances of absconding. On these grounds, prosecution prayed that application be rejected.

5. The Hon'ble High Court imposed condition on accused No.13 that he shall not leave the State of Maharashtra without prior permission of the Trial Court. Considering the reasons put forth and period of travel, the application is deserves to be allowed. Hence, I pass the following order:-

ORDER

1. Application Exh.234 is allowed.
2. Accused No.13 Vimal Mohanlal Jain is permitted to travel to Coimbatore from 13.08.2026 to 17.08.2026.

3. The accused No.13 shall not misuse the said facility and shall remain present for trial after his arrival as mentioned above.
4. Application Exh.234 stands disposed of accordingly.
