ORDER

1. This order of mine shall dispose of an application filed by the applicant on behalf of accused Amrik Singh. It was submitted that the applicant/accused is quite innocent and he has not committed any offence. He has been falsely implicated in the present case without investigating the matter thoroughly by the police. The applicant has not committed any offence as alleged in the case. No recovery of any type has been effected from the applicant as the applicant has no concern or connection with the other accused. The applicant has no role in the commission of any offence as alleged in the FIR. The accused is in judicial custody since 5.4.2024. The presentation of challan and conclusion of the trial shall take long time. No purpose shall be served by detaining the applicant behind bars. It was further submitted that the applicant undertakes not to tamper with the prosecution evidence. Lastly, the learned counsel for the applicant/accused prayed that his application be allowed.

2. Reply to this application has not been filed by the prosecution but bail application was hotly contested.

 ASI Baljit Singh come present and produced police record and also produced one peforma containing the necessary information regarding role of accused Amrik Singh. It is was also mentioned in the bail application that it is first bail application of accused Amrik Singh.

3. The rival contentions of both the parties are heard in light of their pleadings and documents on record. It is application of the applicant/accused that accused has been falsely implicated in present case. No offence has been committed by accused. The accused is in judicial custody and no recovery has been effected from applicant. Perusal of police record shows that present FIR has been lodged against accused/applicant Amrik Singh along with co-accused Manjit Kaur, Malika and Gurpal Singh . It is allegation against accused Malkit Singh that he introduced accused Manjit Kaur with complainant and by showing forged and fake agreement to sell in the name of Manjit singh, they grab Rs. 58,17,000/- from complainant on the pretext of selling him the H.No. 5523 Sector 38 (West) Chandigarh. The allegations against accused are serious in nature as they have received huge money from complainant. Moreover, investigation is at initial stage and there are every possibility that accused may temper with evidence if release on bail. Thus, keeping in view the seriousness of allegations accused did not deserve the leniency of the bail at this stage. Therefore, the bail application of the accused is hereby dismissed. Papers be attached with remand papers/FIR.
