Upon perusing the entire case records and having stood over for consideration till this day this court delivered the following:

ORDER

This Petition filed U/S 151 CPC seeking permission to reopen the plaintiff side evidence to examine further witness.

Records perused. Petitioner filed petition to reopen the plaintiff side evidence to examine further witness. Petitioner side submitted that inorder to prove his case the exmination of further witness is necessary. Hence he prays to allow this petition. Counsel for 1st and 2nd Respondents submitted as this petition filed to drag on the proceedings and the petition was very vague and untenable one. Hence counsel for 1st and 2nd respondents prays to dismiss this petition.

Records perused. Petition filed by the Petitioner seeking permission to reopen the plaintiff side evidence in order to examine further witness. This case is pending in the stage of defendant side evidence. PW1 evidence closed on 19.09.2025. From 26.09.2025 to 06.11.2025 plaintiff not ready to let evidence. Hence plaintiff side evidence closed on 06.11.2025. No valuable reasons stated in the petition for not examining the witness in time. Considering the fact and circumstances to prevent the multiplicity of proceedings, to provide the petitioners an opportunity to prove their case and for proper adjudication of the case, this petition has to be allowed on costs.

In the result, this petition is allowed on condition that the petitioner has to pay a cost of Rs.500/- each to R1, R2 on or before 10.02.2026 failing which this petition stands dismissed. Call on 10.02.2026.
