Reply to the afore-mentioned application has already been filed by IO.

Ld. Counsel for applicant / accused Pawandeep Singh has submitted that the applicant / accused Pawandeep Singh wants to travel to China 15.10.2023 to 23.10.2023 as he has received an invitation letter dated 26.07.2023 from Xiamen Fuke Car Accessories Co. Ltd and Schenzhen Jitu Technology Co Ltd in order to visit and gather different accessories and parts. The relevant documents containing itinerary has been annexed along with the present application.

Ld. Counsel for applicant / accused Pawandeep Singh has further submitted that while granting bail to the applicant / accused Pawandeep Singh vide order dated 23.03.2022, a condition was imposed upon him that he shall not leave the city without prior permission of the Court.

He further argued that he is ready to abide any condition imposed by the Court while granting the above sought permission.

On the other hand, Ld. Addl PP for state along with the Ld. Counsel for Complainant has strongly opposed the aforementioned application. Ld. Counsel for Complainant has argued the present application seeking permission to travel to China has been moved on vague grounds as per details attached along with the present application, the applicant / accused has been invited for business purpose. He has prayed that the present application may kindly be dismissed.

Submissions Heard.

Perusal of the record shows that vide order dated 23.03.2022, applicant / accused Pawandeep Singh was admitted to bail by my Ld. Predecessor and while granting bail, conditions were imposed that he would deposit his passport before the Court and would not leave the city without prior permission of the Court. In the present application, applicant / accused Pawandeep Singh has sought permission of the Court to travel to china from 15.10.2023 to 23.10.2023 for business purposes. Copies of tickets of applicant / accused are also annexed with the present application. It is prayed by applicant / accused Pawandeep Singh that if he is not allowed to travel to China by the Court, he would suffer irreparable loss.

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Keeping in view of the above discussed facts and circumstances, the present application is hereby allowed and applicant / accused Pawandeep Singh is permitted to travel to China from 15.10.2023 to 23.10.2023. Applicant / accused is further directed to deposit his passport immediately after his return to India in the Court.

Be put up the file for the purpose and date already fixed i.e., on **02.11.2023 and 03.11.2023**.
