Petition dated 24.02.2026, Praying to grant bail for the petitioners:-

This bail Petition is coming on this day for hearing before me, filed by the petitioners counsel Thiru. R. Sureshkumar, Advocate with the reply of the learned Assistant public prosecutor or the respondent/police, upon perusing the records, materials and heard both sides, this court made the following...

ORDER

The counsel for the petitioners states that they were arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 20.02.2026 for alleged offences under sections 329(4), 296(b), 308(2), 351(3), 3(5) BNS by the respondent police. They are innocent and not connected with any crime. The learned counsel for the petitioners states that the petitioners are under Judicial custody from 20.02.2026. They are ready to abide any conditions imposed by this court upon his release. Hence this petition may be allowed.

Bail Objection on the side of prosecution/Police

The prosecution submits that the offence committed by the petitioners/Accused were a serious one. It is submitted that the above said case investigation is still pending. In particular, if accused persons are released on bail they may indulge in similar type of offence in future and also will tamper and hamper the investigation.

It is the first bail petition filed by the petitioners who are in Judicial custody from 20.02.2026. The petitioner has been in judicial custody for 22 days. Co-accused released on bail. Hence, Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, nature of the offence and period of remand and for interest of justice, this court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioners on following conditions:

1) The Petitioners are ordered to be released on execution of bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties.

2) The Petitioners will appear and sign before the concerned police station daily at 10.30 a.m. for 30 days and they shall be available for investigation as and when required by the investigating officer.

3) They should not tamper or hamper the witnesses and indulge in any other offences.
