Petition dated 02.03.2026, Praying to grant bail for the petitioner:-

This bail Petition is coming on this day for hearing before me, filed by the petitioner counsel Thiru. M. Murugesan advocate with the reply of the learned Assistant public prosecutor or the respondent/police, upon perusing the records, materials and heard both sides, this court made the following...

ORDER

The petitioner state that he was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 27.02.2026 for alleged offences under sections 306 BNS by the respondent police. He is innocent and not connected with any crime. The learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is under Judicial custody from 27.02.2026. He is ready to abide any conditions imposed by this court upon his release. Hence this petition may be allowed.

Bail Objection on the side of prosecution/Police

The prosecution submits that the offence committed by the petitioner/Accused was a serious one. It is submitted that the above said case investigation is still pending. In particular, if accused person is released on bail he may indulge in similar type of offence in future and also will tamper and hamper the investigation.

It is the first bail petition filed by the petitioner who is in Judicial custody from 27.02.2026. The petitioner has been in judicial custody for 8 days and the investigation is still pending. Offences alleged are serious in nature. Hence, considering the facts and circumstances of the case, nature of the offence and period of the remand, this petition is dismissed.
