The petition dated 14-07-2026 U/s.480 BNSS praying to enlarge the petitioner on Bail.

This petition coming on this day for hearing before me having filed the petition by the petitioner counsel M/s. V. Manimaran, Rishi, Guruparan reply of the Learned Assistant Public Prosecutor Gr-I for the State/ Respondent, upon Perusing the records and material Both sides Heard this court made the following.

ORDER

The petition is filed u/s 480 BNSS seeking release of the accused on bail. Notice given to concerned police and reply received. The concerned police raised objections to release the petitioner on Bail.

The Petitioner is facing charges **u/s.306 BNS** in Crime No.418/2026 of V3 JJ Nagar Police Station. The petitioner/Accused is in judicial Custody from 02-07-2026. The Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner/Accused is innocent and did not involve in the alleged offence.

Learned Assistant Public Prosecutor would object on the ground that the investigation is pending. The Petitioner/Accused may likely to tamper the witness and hamper the investigation. Hence, the Petitioner/Accused released on bail possibility of absconding as well as recurrence of similar crime.

Rival submission of both sides considered. Upon considering the strong objections facts and circumstances of the case and other facts. Case property is not recovered. Already bail petition in Crlmp.No.913/2026 is dismissed. The Offence of is grave in nature and the investigation has not yet been completed. This Court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner / Accused. Hence this petition is dismissed.

Accordingly this petition is dismissed.
