This case came up for final hearing before me and this case having been stood over for consideration before this court till date, this court is inclined to deliver the following;

ORDER

This Petition was filed to receive additional documents by the petitioner/complainant.

- 1) This petition was filed to receive additional document. The petitioner/Complainant in his petition stated that initially he had filed 10 documents while filing this complaint. Thereafter it is alleged that the xerox copy of News paper advertisement, details of purchased car & certified copy of final report in Cr.No.296/2020 was to be filed. Further stated these document were necessary to prove his case. Hence prayed to allow this petition.
- 2) Per contra to the same the respondent/accused in his counter has stated as if reason for not submitting those document at the time of filing the case was not mentioned. Further states those documents were not admissible in evidence. Hence prayed to dismiss the petition.
- 3) Heard both sides. Records perused. On perusal of case records it seems it is alleged by the complainant that based on a advertisement in newspaper by the accused the complainant agreed to invest in second hand cars and from. which it is clear that the documents stated in this petition to receive the same seems vital for the just decision of this case. Further though reason for filing the same has not been particularly stated in the petition and no affidavit was filed the same cannot be viewed into a straight jacket compliance since NI act being a special enactment and on perusal of available record this court feels that receiving such document were vital for the just decision. Further by receiving the same the respondent / accused would not get prejudice since he is having every right to cross examine in connection with documents filed. Hence in the interest of justice petition allowed. No cost.
