Petition dated 26.02.2026 U/s.482 BNSS to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

This petition is coming on this day for hearing before this court in the presence of **Thiru.M.Madasamy**, Advocate for the Petitioner and **Thiru.M.P.K.Maruthappan**, Public Prosecutor for the Respondent/complainant and upon hearing both sides, this Court passed the following :

**ORDER**

Petitioner/accused seeks anticipatory bail for the alleged offences under section 296(b) of BNS and section 3 of TNPPDL Act registered by the Respondent police.

The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that this petitioner was granted anticipatory bail by this court in Cr..M.P.No. 34/2026 dated 07.01.2026 and this petitioner is taking treatment in Trivandrum Dhanvanthri Hospital and due to this he is not able to surrender before the court within the stipulated time and prays to grant II anticipatory bail to the petitioner herein.

The learned Public Prosecutor submitted that this petitioner has granted already anticipatory bail in Cr.M.P.No.34/2026 on 07.01.2026.

Heard. The submissions of both sides considered. Considering the facts that

this petitioner has already granted anticipatory bail and due to medical issues and the petitioner is not able to surrender before the court and other facts and circumstances, this court is inclined to grant II anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

In the result this petition is allowed subject to following conditions.

- i) That in the event of arrest of the petitioner by the Respondent/police or on his surrender before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Shencottai within 15 days from the date of this order and on such arrest or surrender the petitioner is ordered to be enlarged on anticipatory bail on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties for a like sum each to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate, Shencottai. **If the petitioner/accused is not surrender within 15 days from the date of this order this Anticipatory bail shall stands cancelled automatically:**
- ii) The sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the sureties shall produce a copy of his Aadhaar card or Solvency Certificate or Bank pass book to ensure their identity.
- iii) **That the petitioner shall report and sign before the Respondent P.S daily once at 10.00 A.M for one month.**
- iv) **That the petitioner has to deposit a sum of Rs.20,000/- before the Judicial Magistrate, Shencottai under the head of Cr.No.306/2025 of respondent P.S., and the said amount has to be kept in Criminal C.D. to be decided in trial and without prejudice to their defence before the trial court.**
- v) **That the petitioner is directed to deposit a sum of Rs. 1,000/- to the Mediation Centre, Tenkasi.**
- vi) That the petitioner has to furnish his Mail I.D and Phone number before the trial court at the time of executing bond.
- vii) The petitioner shall make available himself for interrogation as and when required by the investigation Officer.
- viii) The petitioner shall not tamper the witness or hamper the evidence in any manner either during investigation or Trial.
- ix) The petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or Trial.
- x) That on breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the Investigation Officer shall report to the learned Magistrate / Trial Court and shall take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law.
- xi) If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered U/S.269 BNS.
