Petition dated 27.02.2026 U/s.483 BNSS to grant bail to the petitioner.

This petition is coming on this day for hearing before this court in the presence of Thiru.A.Kathapandi, Advocate for the Petitioner and Thiru.M.P.K.Maruthappan, Public Prosecutor for the Respondent/complainant and upon hearing both sides, this Court passed the following :

ORDER

The Petitioner/accused was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 18.02.2026 for the alleged offences punishable under sections 296(b), 109, 351(3) of BNS registered by the respondent police, seeks bail.

The learned Counsel for the petitioner/accused would submit that due to previous motive backdrop the whole occurrence taken place and no one sustained injury in this case and this petitioner is undergoing incarceration for the past 16 days and prays to grant bail to the petitioner subject to any conditions.

The learned Public Prosecutor would submit that this petitioner alone involved in this case and the allegation against this petitioner is that due to previous motive in dashing the door of the load auto against one Kannan and while asking Rs.10,000/-

for treatment, this petitioner abused the defacto complainant with filthy language and also attempted the life of him and also threatened him with dire consequences and this petitioner is a history sheeted rowdy element and H.S.No.253/2024 and he is having 4 previous cases and the investigation is not yet completed and hence strongly objected to release the petitioner on bail.

Heard. Records perused. The submissions of both sides were considered. This petitioner alone involved in this case and the allegation against this petitioner is that due to previous motive in dashing the door of the load auto against one Kannan and while asking Rs.10,000/- for treatment, this petitioner abused the defacto complainant with filthy language and also attempted the life of him and also threatened him with dire consequences. Eventhough this petitioner is undergoing incarceration for the past 16 days and no one sustained injury in this case, considering the fact that this petitioner is a history sheeted rowdy element and H.S.No.253/2024 and he is having 4 previous cases and the investigation is not yet completed and the strong objection submitted by the learned Public Prosecutor and the attitude and the antecedents of the petitioner and other facts and circumstances, this court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

In the result this petition is dismissed.
