Petition dated 02.03.2026 U/s.483 BNSS to grant bail to the petitioner.

This petition is coming on this day for hearing before this court in the presence of Thiru.M.Elayaraja, Advocate for the Petitioner and Thiru.M.P.K.Maruthappan, Public Prosecutor for the Respondent/complainant and upon hearing both sides, this Court passed the following :

ORDER

The Petitioner/accused was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 01.02.2026 for the alleged offences punishable under section 318(4) BNS & section 66D IT Act registered by the respondent police, seeks bail.

The learned Counsel for the petitioner/accused would submit that out of 6 accused persons, this petitioner being A2 in this case and this petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case and this is purely put up case only and this petitioner is only seller of the sim card and he is no way connected with the occurrence and there is no overtact against this petitioner and this petitioner is undergoing incarceration for the past 33 days and prays to grant bail to the petitioner subject to any conditions.

The learned Public Prosecutor would submit that totally 6 accused involved in this case and this petitioner being A2 in rank and the allegation against the accused persons is that they cheated the defacto complainant by taking money from his account through online and this petitioner is a main mediator for this occurrence and this petitioner was detained under Goondas Act for his previous involvements in cyber crime offences and M.H.S.No.24/2026 and the investigation is not yet completed and if the petitioner is released on bail he will abscond and will commit the same offence again and hence strongly objected to release the petitioner on bail.

Heard. Records perused. The submissions of both sides were considered. Totally 6 accused involved in this case and this petitioner being A2 in rank and the allegation against the accused persons is that they cheated the defacto complainant by taking money from his account through online. Eventhough this petitioner is undergoing incarceration for the past 33 days, considering the fact that this petitioner is a main mediator for this occurrence and this petitioner was detained under Goondas Act for his previous involvements in cyber crime offences and M.H.S.No.24/2026 and the investigation is not yet completed and if the petitioner is released on bail he will abscond and will commit the same offence again and the strong objection submitted by the learned Public Prosecutor and the attitude and the antecedents of the petitioner and other facts and circumstances, this court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

In the result this petition is dismissed.
