Petition dated 02.03.2026 U/s.482 BNSS to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

This petition is coming on this day for hearing before this court in the presence of **Thiru.R.David Nirmal Durai**, Advocate for the petitioners and **Thiru.M.P.K.Maruthappan**, Public Prosecutor for the Respondent/complainant and upon hearing both sides, this Court passed the following :

ORDER

Petitioners/accused seeks anticipatory bail for the alleged offences under Sections 4(1)(A), 4(1) (C) of TNP Act registered by the Respondent police.

The learned Counsel for the petitioner/accused would submit that this petitioner was not bodily present in the scene of occurrence and the brandy bottles were recovered from A.1 and he was released on bail by the trial court and this petitioner has no previous case and he is ready to abide any condition and prays to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner herein.

The learned Public Prosecutor would submit that totally 2 accused Petitioner is A.2 and A.1 is in possession of 27 brandy bottles value Rs. 3780/- and selling the

same to the public and the brandy bottles and sales amount Rs. 1550/- were recovered and this petitioner has 18 previous cases.

Heard. Records perused. The submissions of both sides were considered. Out of 2 accused petitioner is being A.2. The allegation is that the accused persons were in possession of 27 brandy bottles value Rs. 3780/- and selling the same to the public and the brandy bottles to the public. Considering the fact that the brandy bottles and the sales amount were recovered and the co-accused was let on bail by the trial court and the attitude of this petitioner and other facts and circumstances, this court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner/accused.

In the result this petition is allowed subject to following conditions.

- i) That in the event of arrest of the petitioners by the Respondent/police or on their surrender before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Alangulam within 15 days from the date of this order and on such arrest or surrender the petitioners are ordered to be enlarged on anticipatory bail on them executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- each (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties for a like sum each to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate, Alangulam. **If the petitioners/accused are not surrender within 15 days from the date of this order this Anticipatory bail shall stands cancelled automatically:**
- ii) The sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the sureties shall produce a copy of their Aadhaar card or Solvency Certificate or Bank pass book to ensure their identity.
- iii) **That the petitioners shall report and sign before the Respondent P.S daily once at 10.00 A.M for one month.**
- iv) That the petitioner has to furnish his Mail I.D and Phone number before the trial court at the time of executing bond.
- v) The petitioners shall make available themselves for interrogation as and when required by the investigation Officer.
- vi) The petitioners shall not tamper the witness or hamper the evidence in any manner either during investigation or Trial.
- vii) The petitioners shall not abscond either during investigation or Trial.
- viii) That on breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the Investigation Officer shall report to the learned Magistrate / Trial Court and shall take appropriate action against the petitioners in accordance with law.
- ix) If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered U/S.269 BNS.
