Petitions dated 02.03.2026 U/s.482 BNSS to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

These petitions are coming on this day for hearing before this court in the presence of **Thiru.K.Chokkalingam**, Advocate for the Petitioner in Cr.M.P.No. 723/2026 and Thiru.M.Sivaramakrishnan, Advocate for the petitioners in Cr.M.P.No.725/2026 and **Thiru.M.P.K.Maruthappan**, Public Prosecutor for the Respondent/complainant and upon hearing both sides, this Court passed the following:

COMMON ORDER

Both of these petitions are one and same crime number. Hence this court pronounce the common order.

Petitioners/accused seeks anticipatory bail for the alleged offences under section 288 of BNS r/w 9(B)(1)(a) of the Explosive Act registered by the Respondent police.

The learned counsel for the petitioners would submit that these petitioners were falsely implicated in this case and these petitioners were in possession of crackers and A.1,2, were released on bail by the Judicial Magistrate Sankarankoil and these petitioners have no previous case and the petitioners are ready to abide any condition and prays to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners herein.

The learned Public Prosecutor submitted that totally 6 accused Petitioners are A.3,4,5 A.1 is running a poultry and the accused persons were in possession of Explosive substances without any valid permit and A.1, 2, 6 was arrested and these petitioners have no previous cases.

Heard. The submissions of both sides considered. Out of 6 accused these petitioners are A.3,4,5. The allegation is that the accused persons were in possession of Explosive substances without any valid permit. Considering the fact that these petitioners have no previous cases and A.1,2 were released on bail by the Judicial Magistrate, Sankarankoil and other facts and circumstances of this case this court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

In the result this petition is allowed subject to following conditions.

- i) That in the event of arrest of the petitioners by the Respondent/police or on their surrender before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Sankarankovil within 15 days from the date of this order and on such arrest or surrender the petitioners are ordered to be enlarged on anticipatory bail on them executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- each (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties for a like sum each to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate, Sankarankovil. **If the petitioners/accused are not surrender within 15 days from the date of this order this Anticipatory bail shall stands cancelled automatically:**
- ii) The sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the sureties shall produce a copy of their Aadhaar card or Solvency Certificate or Bank pass book to ensure their identity.
- iii) **That the petitioners shall report and sign before the Respondent P.S daily once at 10.00 A.M for one month.**
- iv) The petitioners shall make available themselves for interrogation as and when required by the investigation Officer.

- v) That the petitioners have to furnish their Mail I.D and Phone number before the trial court at the time of executing bond.
- vi) The petitioners shall not tamper the witness or hamper the evidence in any manner either during investigation or Trial.
- vii) The petitioners shall not abscond either during investigation or Trial.
- viii) That on breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the Investigation Officer shall report to the learned Magistrate / Trial Court and shall take appropriate action against the petitioners in accordance with law.
- ix) If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered U/S.269 BNS.
