Petition dated 05.03.2026 U/s.483 BNSS to grant bail to the petitioner.

This petition is coming on this day for hearing before this court in the presence of Thiru.M.Elayaraja, Advocate for the Petitioner and Thiru.M.P.K.Maruthappan, Public Prosecutor for the Respondent/complainant and upon hearing both sides, this Court passed the following :

### **ORDER**

The Petitioner/accused was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 28.02.2026 for the alleged offences punishable under section 311 of BNS registered by the respondent police, seeks bail.

The learned Counsel for the petitioner/accused would submit that out of 7 accused persons, this petitioner being A1 in this case and due to wordy quarrel backdrop the whole occurrence taken place and this petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case and this is purely put up case only and this petitioner is no way connected with the occurrence and no overtact against this petitioner and this petitioner is undergoing incarceration for the past 8 days and prays to grant bail to the petitioner subject to any conditions.

The learned Public Prosecutor would submit that totally 7 accused involved in this case and this petitioner being A1 in rank and the allegation against the accused persons is that they called the defacto complainant through Loconto App and attacked him and robbed Rs.3,000/- from him and the injured in this case was discharged from the hospital and the amount also recovered and the investigation is pending and strongly objected to release the petitioner on bail.

Heard. Records perused. The submissions of both sides were considered. Totally 7 accused involved in this case and this petitioner being A5 in rank and the allegation against the accused persons is that they called the defacto complainant through Loconto App and attacked him and robbed Rs.3,000/- from him. Considering the fact that the short period of incarceration of this petitioner and the investigation is pending and the strong objection submitted by the learned public Prosecutor and the nature of offence and the attitude and the antecedents of the petitioner and other facts and circumstances, this court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

In the result this petition is dismissed.
