Petition dated 05.03.2026 U/s.483 BNSS to grant bail to the petitioner.

This petition is coming on this day for hearing before this court in the presence of Thiru.M.Kilipandi, Advocate for the Petitioner and Thiru.M.P.K.Maruthappan, Public Prosecutor for the Respondent/complainant and upon hearing both sides, this Court passed the following :

### **ORDER**

The Petitioner/accused was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 01.12.2025 for the alleged offences punishable under section 103 of BNS registered by the respondent police, seeks bail.

The learned Counsel for the petitioner/accused would submit that this petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case and this is purely put up case only and no one included in the F.I.R. as accused and when this petitioner went to comply the condition as per the condition imposed in the bail order already granted to this petitioner in another one case, the respondent police arrested this petitioner for this case by stating false allegation and this petitioner is no way connected with the

occurrence and this petitioner is undergoing incarceration for the past 97 days and prays to grant bail to the petitioner subject to any conditions.

The learned Public Prosecutor would submit that the allegation against this petitioner is that due to previous enmity, he murdered a person and charge sheet in this case has been filed and not yet numbered and this petitioner has been detained under Goondas Act and hence strongly objected to release the petitioner on bail.

Heard. Records perused. The submissions of both sides were considered. The allegation against this petitioner is that due to previous enmity, he murdered a person. Eventhough this petitioner is undergoing incarceration for the past 97 days, considering the fact that the nature of offence and this petitioner is detained under Goondas Act and the attitude and the antecedents of the petitioner and other facts and circumstances, this court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

In the result this petition is dismissed.
