Petition dated 05.03.2026 U/s.483 BNSS to grant bail to the petitioner.

This petition is coming on this day for hearing before this court in the presence of Thiru.S.Mariganesh, Advocate for the Petitioner appeared through video conference and Thiru.M.P.K.Maruthappan, Public Prosecutor for the Respondent/complainant and upon hearing both sides, this Court passed the following :

ORDER

The Petitioner/accused was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 01.02.2026 for the alleged offences punishable under section 318(4) of BNS and section 66 D of the IT Act registered by the respondent police, seeks bail.

The learned Counsel for the petitioner/accused would submit that this petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case and this is purely put up case only and no direct transaction to this petitioner's account and this petitioner is no way connected with the occurrence and this petitioner has no knowledge about the occurrence and this petitioner has no previous case and this petitioner is undergoing

incarceration for the past 35 days and this is II bail application and prays to grant bail to the petitioner subject to any conditions.

The learned Public Prosecutor would submit that totally 6 accused involved in this case and this petitioner being A5 in rank and the allegation against the accused persons is that the defacto complainant is working in a private wind mill situated at Uthumalai and the accused persons cheated the defacto complainant through online trading and the defacto complainant has sustained a loss of Rs.5,83,007/- and this petitioner is one of the party in the above said link and the investigation is pending.

Heard. Records perused. The submissions of both sides were considered. Totally 6 accused involved in this case and this petitioner being A5 in rank and the allegation against the accused persons is that the defacto complainant is working in a private wind mill situated at Uthumalai and the accused persons cheated the defacto complainant through online trading and the defacto complainant has sustained a loss of Rs.5,83,007/-. Eventhough this petitioner is undergoing incarceration for the past 35 days and this is II bail application, considering the fact that the nature of offence and the investigation is not yet completed and some of the facts has to be unearthed from this petitioner and no change of circumstances in this case and the attitude and the antecedents of the petitioner and other facts and circumstances, this court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

In the result this petition is dismissed.
