Petition dated 05.03.2026 U/s.482 BNSS to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

This petition is coming on this day for hearing before this court in the presence of **Thiru.S.Pushparaj**, Advocate for the Petitioner and **Thiru.M.P.K.Maruthappan**, Public Prosecutor for the Respondent/complainant and upon hearing both sides, this Court passed the following :

ORDER

Petitioner/accused seeks anticipatory bail for the alleged offences under section 296(b), 118(1), 109 and 351(3) of BNS registered by the Respondent police.

The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioners and the victim are relatives and there is a civil dispute between them regarding land property on the date of occurrence the victim damaged this petitioners two wheeler on the same was questioned by this petitioner and there arose wordy quarrel and the victim assaulted this petitioner with sickle and this petitioner sustained injuries in both hand fingers and taking treatment in TVMC Hospital and this being case in counter, counter case Cr. No.57/2026 and the injured in this case was discharged from the hospital and this petitioner has no previous case and this being case in

counter and the petitioner is ready to abide any condition and prays to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner herein.

The learned Public Prosecutor submitted that due to ancestral property dispute this petitioner attempted on the life of the victim with sickle and caused injuries in the vital part and the injured was discharged from the hospital and this being case in counter and Counter case Cr. No 57/2026 and this petitioner has no previous cases.

Heard. The submissions of both sides considered. Considering the fact that the injured in this case was discharged from the hospital and this petitioner has no previous case and this being case in counter and other facts and circumstances of this case this court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

In the result this petition is allowed subject to following conditions.

- i) That in the event of arrest of the petitioner by the Respondent/police or on his surrender before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Sankarankovil within 15 days from the date of this order and on such arrest or surrender the petitioner is ordered to be enlarged on anticipatory bail on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties for a like sum each to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate, Sankarankovil. **If the petitioner/accused is not surrender within 15 days from the date of this order this Anticipatory bail shall stands cancelled automatically:**
- ii) The sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the sureties shall produce a copy of his Aadhaar card or Solvency Certificate or Bank pass book to ensure their identity.
- iii) **That the petitioner shall report and sign before the Tirunelveli Town P.S daily once at 10.00 A.M for one month.**
- iv) **The Petitioner has to furnish his Mail ID and Phone number before the trial court at the time of executing bond.**
- v) The petitioner shall make available himself for interrogation as and when required by the investigation Officer.
- vi) The petitioner shall not tamper the witness or hamper the evidence in any manner either during investigation or Trial.
- vii) The petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or Trial.
- viii) That on breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the Investigation Officer shall report to the learned Magistrate / Trial Court and shall take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law.
- ix) If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered U/S.269 BNS.
