This petition is coming on this day for hearing before this court in the presence of **Thiru.S.Palani Devaram**, Advocate for the petitioner and **Thiru.M.P.K.Maruthappan**, Public Prosecutor for the Respondent/complainant and upon hearing both sides, this Court passed the following :

ORDER

The petitioner/accused who was granted vide anticipatory bail order of this Court in Cr.MP.No.610/2026, dated 24.02.2026 that, the petitioner shall report and sign before the respondent Police daily once at 10.00 A.M.for one month and has now filed this petition seeking to relax the condition imposed on him.

The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that, the petitioner has been complying the condition from 26.02.2026 and this petitioner is suffering from spinalcord disease and prays to relax the condition imposed on him.

The learned Public Prosecutor would submit that, the petitioner has been observed the condition only for 11 days and the condition imposed for 30 days.

After taking into consideration of both sides, considering the fact that the petitioner has been complying the condition for the past 11 days and this petitioner is suffering from spinal-cord disease and this Court is inclined to relax the condition imposed on the petitioner.

In the result, the petition is allowed and the above said condition imposed on the petitioner is totally relaxed and with a condition the petitioner should appear before the court on all the hearing dates without fail. Other conditions remains unchanged.
