Petition dated 07.03.2026 U/s.483 BNSS to grant bail to the petitioner.

This petition is coming on this day for hearing before this court in the presence of Thiru.M.Elayaraja, Advocate for the Petitioner and Thiru.M.P.K.Maruthappan, Public Prosecutor for the Respondent/complainant and upon hearing both sides, this Court passed the following :

### **ORDER**

The Petitioner/accused was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 12.02.2026 for the alleged offences punishable under section 318(4) of BNS and 66 D IT Act registered by the respondent police, seeks bail.

The learned Counsel for the petitioner/accused would submit that totally 6 accused arrested and remanded to judicial custody in this case and this petitioner being A1 in this case and A1, A3 and A4 are friends and A3 is kept a cellphone and sim selling shop and A3 received details from A1 & A4 and transferred the amount to A5 and A3 is the kingpin to this occurrence and this petitioner is aged about 23 years and completed his Mechanical Engineering studies and working at Singapore and there are 49 days delay in registering F.I.R. and this

petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case and this is purely put up case only and no specific overtact against this petitioner and this petitioner has no previous case and this petitioner is undergoing incarceration for the past 28 days and prays to grant bail to the petitioner subject to any conditions.

The learned Public Prosecutor would submit that totally 6 accused involved in this case and this petitioner being A1 in rank and the allegation against the accused persons is that they technically cheated the defacto complainant through online by taking money from his bank account and it is a pramide size transferring the amount to the accounts to various states of India and this petitioner is prime accused in this case and A1 and A6 are detained under Goondas Act and M.H.S. Nos. 26/2026 and 27/2026 respectively and the investigation is pending.

Heard. Records perused. The submissions of both sides were considered. Totally 6 accused involved in this case and this petitioner being A1 in rank and the allegation against the accused persons is that they technically cheated the defacto complainant through online by taking money from his bank account and it is a pramide size transferring the amount to the accounts to various state of India. Eventhough this petitioner is undergoing incarceration for the past 28 days and this is II bail application, considering the fact that the nature of offence and A1 and A6 are detained under Goondas Act and M.H.S. Nos. 26/2026 and 27/2026 respectively and the investigation is going on and some of the facts has to be unearthed from this petitioner and there is no change of circumstances in this case and the attitude and the antecedents of these petitioner and other facts and circumstances, this Court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner/accused in all the petitions.

In the result this petition is dismissed.
