This petition is coming on this day for hearing before this court in the presence of **Thiru.M.Chinthamani**, Advocate for the Petitioner and **Thiru.M.P.K.Maruthappan**, Public Prosecutor for the Respondent/complainant and upon hearing both sides, this Court passed the following :

ORDER

Petitioner/accused seeks anticipatory bail for the alleged offences under section 296(b), 311, 351(3) of BNS registered by the Respondent police.

The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that due to wordy quarrel the whole occurrence taken place and the injured in this case was discharged from the hospital and this petitioner has no previous case and this petitioner is taking treatment for his liver and this is II Petition and the petitioner is ready to abide any condition and prays to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner herein.

The learned Public Prosecutor submitted that totally 6 accused Petitioner is A.2. and A.1 is the leader of the team and other accused are juvenile A.3,4,5,6 are

arrested while the victim was in the bricks -yard the accused persons were attacked the victim with Aruval and demanded money and stolen Rs.1500/-from the pocket and also taken the cell phone value of R.6000/- and caused injuries and the injured in this case was discharged from the hospital and this petitioner has no previous case and the investigation is pending.

Heard. The submissions of both sides considered. Out of 6 accused this petitioner is being A.2 and A.1 is the leader of the team and other accused are juvenile A.3,4,5,6 are arrested while the victim was in the brick-yard the accused persons were attacked the victim with Aruval and stolen Rs. 1500/-from the pocket and also taken the cell phone value of R.6000/-. Eventhough no specific overtact as against this petitioner Considering the fact that the stolen properties were not recovered and the attitude of this petitioner and this is II Petition and there is no change is circumstances and other facts and circumstances this court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

In the result this petition is dismissed.
