After taking into consideration of both sides, considering the fact that the petitioner has been complying the condition for the past 22 days this Court is inclined to relax the condition imposed on the petitioner.

**In the result, the petition is allowed and the above said condition imposed on the petitioner is totally relaxed and with a condition the petitioner should appear before the court on all the hearing dates without fail. Other conditions remains unchanged.**
