Petition dated 10.03.2026 U/s.483 BNSS to grant bail to the petitioner.

This petition is coming on this day for hearing before this court in the presence of Thiru.M.Ayyadurai, Advocate for the Petitioner and Thiru.M.P.K.Maruthappan, Public Prosecutor for the Respondent/complainant and upon hearing both sides, this Court passed the following :

ORDER

The Petitioner/accused was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 05.03.2026 for the alleged offences punishable under sections 4 of TNPHW Act and 66E, 67, 67A of IT Act and section 75(1), 75(2), 75(3), 78, 79 of BNS registered by the respondent police, seeks bail.

The learned Counsel for the petitioner/accused would submit that this petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case and this purely put up case only and this petitioner has no previous cases and this petitioner is undergoing incarceration for the past 8 days and prays to grant bail to the petitioner subject to any conditions.

The learned Public Prosecutor would submit that this petitioner alone involved in this case and the allegation against this petitioner is that the petitioner contacted

the defacto complainant through Instagram, made her send him nude photos, and forced her to send other photos again and also threatening her to post the nude photos on WhatsApp if she did not send photos and this petitioner is having 4 sim cards with different numbers and lot of groups as said above and cheated the married women and the investigation is still pending.

Heard. Records perused. The submissions of both sides were considered. This petitioner alone involved in this case and the allegation against this petitioner is that the petitioner contacted the defacto complainant through Instagram, made her send him nude photos, and forced her to send other photos again and also threatening her to post the nude photos on Whats App if she did not send photos and this petitioner is having 4 sim cards with different numbers and lot of groups as said above and cheated the married women. Considering the fact that the nature of offence and the short period of incarceration of this petitioner and the attitude and the antecedents of the petitioner and other facts and circumstances, this court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

In the result this petition is dismissed.
