Petition dated 10.03.2026 U/s.483 BNSS to grant bail to the petitioner.

This petition is coming on this day for hearing before this court in the presence of Thiru.D.Pugalvendhan, Advocate for the Petitioner and Thiru.M.P.K.Maruthappan, Public Prosecutor for the Respondent/complainant and upon hearing both sides, this Court passed the following :

**ORDER**

The Petitioner/accused was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 12.01.2026 for the alleged offences punishable under sections 468, 471, 473, 34 of IPC and section 4(1)(Aaa), 4(1A) of TNP Act registered by the respondent police, seeks bail.

The learned Counsel for the petitioner/accused would submit that due to non appearance of this petitioner on 08.12.2025 NBW was issued and he was secured on 12.01.2026 and due to illness of this petitioner he was not able to attend the court and this petitioner is undergoing incarceration for the past 60 days and this petitioner has to children and he is the sole breadwinner of his family and he is a sugar patient and the investigation in this case was completed and pending in S.C.No.532/2025

before the Chief Judicial Magistrate Court, Tenkasi and prays to grant bail to the petitioner subject to any conditions.

The learned Public Prosecutor would submit that this petitioner is A5 in rank in this case and it is a case of jumped out of bail and NBW issued on 08.12.2025 and this petitioner was secured on 12.01.2026 and due to non appearance of this petitioner the case was not able to conduct and the case is pending for a long period before the Chief Judicial Magistrate Court, Tenkasi in S.C.No.532/2025 and if the petitioner is released on bail he will abscond and again commit the same offence and hence strongly objected to release the petitioner on bail.

Heard. Records perused. The submissions of both sides were considered. The allegation is that it is a case of jumped out of bail and due to non appearance of this petitioner on 08.12.2025 NBW was issued and this petitioner was secured by the respondent. Considering the fact that due to non appearance of this petitioner the case was not able to conduct and pending in S.C.No.532/2025 on the file of Chief Judicial Magistrate Court and if the petitioner is released on bail there is a chance to abscond and involved in same kind offence again and the attitude and the antecedents of this petitioner and other facts and circumstances, this court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner/accused.

In the result, this petition is dismissed.
