ORDER

The petitioner has filed this petition to amend the section in the order passed in Cr.M.P.No.675/2026, dt: 27.02.2026 in the anticipatory bail order granted by this court.

The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner was granted anticipatory bail order in Cr.M.P.No. 675/2026 dated 27.02.2026 and the petition instead of section 4(1)(A) it has been wrongly mentioned the section as 4(1)(a) it is typographical error and it is neither wanton or willful, and would further submit 15 days time granted was going to lapsed and further extension of time to

surrender before the trial court may also be extended and prays to allow the petition.

The learned Public Prosecutor has not raised any objection to amend the section as stated in this petition.

Considering the representation of bothsides, the nature of the amendment sought by the petitioner and the earlier antecedents of the petitioner filing petition for modification of the condition before surrendering of court and now seeking extension of time this court is inclined to allow this petition subject to the following condition.

In the result, this petition is allowed and ordered to amend to the effect that instead of section “ 4(1)(a) “section “ 4(1)(A) “ has been changed in the petition and anticipatory bail order passed by this court in Cr.M.P.No.675/2026, dt: 27.03.2026 is **extended till 18.03.2026 and also with a condition that the petitioner shall stay at Madurai and report before the Madurai Thallkulam P.S. for one month** and other conditions remains unchanged.
