This petition is coming on this day for hearing before this court in the presence of **Thiru.S.Ganesan**, Advocate for the Petitioner and **Thiru.M.P.K.Maruthappan**, Public Prosecutor for the Respondent/complainant and upon hearing both sides, this Court passed the following :

### **ORDER**

Petitioner/accused seeks anticipatory bail for the alleged offences under section 296(b), 351(3) of BNS and section 3 of TNPPDL Act registered by the Respondent police.

The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the illegal conduct between the defacto complainant wife and this petitioner this false has case been foisted against this petitioner and nobody sustained injury in this case and this petitioner has no previous case and the petitioner is ready to abide any condition and prays to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner herein.

The learned Public Prosecutor submitted that the petitioner and the defacto complainant are neighbours and dispute between the Gandhi Nagar 3<sup>rd</sup> street and

Kamarajar Nagar 3<sup>rd</sup> street people and caused damages to the two wheeler and nobody sustained injury in this case and this petitioner has no previous case.

Heard. The submissions of both sides considered. The allegation is that the petitioner and the defacto complainant are neighbours and dispute between the Gandhi Nagar 3<sup>rd</sup> street and Kamarajar Nagar 3<sup>rd</sup> street people and caused damages to the two wheeler. Eventhough nobody sustained injury in this case Considering the fact that the group clash between the two street people and caused damages to the motor cycle and other facts and circumstances of this case this court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

In the result this petition is dismissed.
