Petition dated 17.03.2026 U/s.483 BNSS to grant bail to the petitioners.

This petition is coming on this day for hearing before this court in the presence of Thiru.B.Gopalakrishnan, Advocate for the petitioners and Thiru.M.P.K.Maruthappan, Public Prosecutor for the Respondent/complainant and upon hearing both sides, this Court passed the following :

ORDER

The Petitioners/accused were arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 09.03.2026 for the alleged offences punishable under sections 296(b), 61(2), 103, 351(3) of BNS registered by the respondent police, seeks bail.

The learned Counsel for the petitioners/accused would submit that out of 4 accused persons these petitioners being A1 and A2 and A1 is brother of deceased and A2 is father-in-law of A1 and A4 is son-in-law of A2 and A3 and A4 only attacked the deceased and these petitioners are no way connected with the occurrence and due to previous motive with regard to the civil dispute the whole occurrence taken place and these petitioners have been falsely implicated in this case and these petitioners

are undergoing incarceration for the past 17 days and prays to grant bail to the petitioners subject to any conditions.

The learned Public Prosecutor would submit that totally 4 accused involved in this case and these petitioners being A.1 and A2 and due to previous enmity with regard to the family property dispute all the accused persons murdered the deceased by slitting with sickle and it is done for revenge and retaliation and already 2 occurrences taken place and it is 3rd occurrence and these petitioners also conspired with other accused and the investigation is still pending and if the petitioners are released on bail, the life of the petitioners also in danger and may abscond and hence strongly objected to release the petitioner on bail.

Heard. Records perused. The submissions of both sides were considered. Totally 4 accused involved in this case and these petitioners being A.1 and A2 and due to previous enmity with regard to the family property dispute all the accused persons murdered the deceased by slitting with sickle and it is done for revenge and retaliation and already 2 occurrences taken place and it is 3rd occurrence and these petitioners also conspired with other accused. Even though these petitioners are undergoing incarceration for the past 17 days, considering the fact that it is a brutal murder and the nature of offence and the strong objection submitted by the learned Public Prosecutor and the attitude and the antecedents of these petitioners and other facts and circumstances, this Court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioners/accused.

In the result this petition is dismissed.
