Petition dt. 29.04.2026 filed u/s 483 of BNSS to grant bail to the petitioner/ accused.

This petition came before this Court on 07.04.2026 in the presence of Thiru.S.Pasumponselvakumar, Advocate for the petitioner/accused and Thiru.S.Velusamy, Additional Public Prosecutor for the respondent/complainant and on hearing both sides and upon perusing the records, this court passed the following

ORDER

This petition has been filed on the side of the petitioner/accused u/s 483 of BNSS seeking bail for the offence punishable u/s 126(2), 296, 103(1), 351(3), 61(2) of BNS registered by the respondent/complainant against the petitioner/accused.

The learned counsel for the petitioner/accused has argued that in this case the petitioner/ accused is in Judicial custody from 19.08.2025 and the petitioner/accused is innocent and this case has been falsely foisted against the petitioner/accused, co-accused has been released on bail by the Hon'ble Principal District Court, Tirunelveli and the Goondas Act filed against the petitioner/accused was set aside by the Hon'ble Madurai Bench of Madras High Court and this petition is 3rd bail application and therefore, the petitioner/accused may be enlarged on bail subject to any conditions.

The learned Additional Public Prosecutor has argued that the the petitioner/accused has abused the the son-in-law of the defacto complainant with filthy language and murdered him with knife along with another accused namely Vignesh and caused his death and he has 11 previous case in Tenkasi P.S. and he is history sheeter and if the

petitioner/accused is released on bail, he would tamper the witnesses and would also abscond to other States. Therefore, the bail petition may be dismissed.

On perusal of case records, it is seen that in this case there are totally two accused persons and the petitioner/accused is the 1st accused. The case of the Prosecution is that since the deceased was abusing the character of the wife of the petitioner/accused on 16.08.2025, the petitioner/accused and the co-accused attacked the deceased with knife and stick respectively and caused his death. This petitioner/accused is in custody from 19.08.2025. Further, the co-accused was released on bail and the Goondas filed against the petitioner/accused was set aside as per the order of Hon'ble Madurai Bench of Madras High Court in H.C.P.(MD) No.386/2026 dt.15.04.2026. Therefore, considering above facts and circumstances of the case, the incarceration period of petitioner/accused and in the interest of Justice, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner/ accused subject to following conditions. Accordingly.

- (i)** The petitioner/ accused is ordered to be enlarged on bail on executing bond for Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand only) with two sureties for the like sum each along with solvency certificates before this Court.
- ii)** The sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and submit the copy of their Aadhaar card or Bank pass book to ensure their identity;
- iii)** The petitioner/ accused shall report and sign before Dharumapuri Town Police Station daily at 10.00 A.M. for one month.
- iv)** The petitioner/ accused shall not tamper with evidence or witness during Trial;
- v)** The petitioner/ accused shall not abscond during Trial.
- vi)** that on breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, appropriate action will be taken against the petitioner/accused in accordance with law.
