Petition dated 02.06.2026 U/s.483 BNSS to grant bail to the petitioner.

This petition is coming on this day for hearing before this court in the presence of Thiru D. Anandanayagam, Advocate for the Petitioner and Thiru. M. P. K. Maruthappan, Public Prosecutor for the Respondent/complainant and upon hearing both sides, this Court passed the following :

ORDER

The Petitioner/accused was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 21.05.2026 for the alleged offences punishable under sections 420, 465, 468, 471 of IPC registered by the respondent police, seeks bail.

The learned Counsel for the petitioner/accused would submit that out of 2 accused persons this petitioner being A2 in rank and this petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case and this is purely put up case only and 3 days belatedly the complaint has been given and F.I.R. was registered and this petitioner is no way connected with the occurrence and this petitioner is not an agent of HDFC ERGO General Insurance Company and this petitioner has no previous case and this

petitioner is undergoing incarceration for the past 15 days and prays to grant bail to the petitioner subject to any conditions.

The learned Public Prosecutor would submit that totally 2 accused persons involved in this case and this petitioner being A2 in rank and he is the introducer of the HDFC ERGO General Insurance Company and the allegation against the accused persons is that they created fake insurance policy by cheating the HDFC ERGO General Insurance Company and it is came to the knowledge of the above said insurance company when M.C.O.P. case was filed after a motor accident and the investigation is not yet completed and if the petitioner is released on bail they will commit the same offence again and may abscond and hence strongly objected to release the petitioner on bail.

Heard. Records perused. The submissions of both sides were considered. Totally 2 accused persons involved in this case and this petitioner being A2 in rank and he is the introducer of the HDFC ERGO General Insurance Company and the allegation against the accused persons is that they created fake insurance policy by cheating the HDFC ERGO General Insurance Company and it is came to the knowledge of the above said insurance company when M.C.O.P. case was filed after a motor accident. Eventhough this petitioner is undergoing incarceration for the past 15 days, considering the fact that the nature of offence and the investigation is not yet completed and the strong objection submitted by the learned Public Prosecutor and the attitude and the antecedents of the petitioner and other facts and circumstances, this court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

In the result this petition is dismissed.
