Petition dated 02.06.2026 U/s.483 BNSS to grant bail to the petitioner.

This petition is coming on this day for hearing before this court in the presence of Thiru.S.Ganesan, Advocate for the Petitioner and Thiru.M.P.K.Maruthappan, Public Prosecutor for the Respondent/complainant and upon hearing both sides, this Court passed the following :

ORDER

The Petitioner/accused was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 09.02.2026 for the alleged offences punishable under sections 61(2), 103(1), 351(3) r/w 49 of BNS registered by the respondent police, seeks bail.

The learned Counsel for the petitioner/accused would submit that out of 9 accused persons this petitioner being A4 in this case and the defacto complainant is mother of the deceased and due to previous motive the whole occurrence taken place and as per the confession statement of A3, this petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case and this petitioner's name does not found place in the F.I.R. and there is no overtact against this petitioner and co-accused in this case has been released on

bail and this petitioner is undergoing incarceration for the past 116 days and prays to grant bail to the petitioner subject to any conditions.

The learned Public Prosecutor would submit that totally 9 accused persons involved in this case and this petitioner being A4 in rank and the allegation against the accused persons is that due to communal disharmony the accused persons murdered the deceased and also threatened the public and it is a brutal murder and also for revenge and for retaliation and this petitioner is the main member of conspiracy and on the instigation of this petitioner, A1 to A3 murdered the deceased and there existing police picketing still in the occurrence place and also there is ever possibility of taking revenge upon this petitioner and the life of the petitioner also in danger and the investigation is completed and this case is charge sheeted and numbered as P.R.C.20/2026 and this petitioner is a history sheeted rowdy element and H.S.No.154/2026 and he is having 4 previous cases and if the petitioner is released on bail he will abscond and hence it is strongly objected to release the petitioner on bail.

Heard. Records perused. The submissions of both sides were considered. Totally 9 accused persons involved in this case and this petitioner being A4 in rank and the allegation against the accused persons is that due to communal disharmony the accused persons murdered the deceased and also threatened the public. Considering the fact that this petitioner is undergoing incarceration for the past 116 days and the co-accused in this case has been released on bail and the investigation is completed and this case has been charge sheeted and numbered as P.R.C.20/2026 and above change of circumstances and the antecedents of this petitioner and other facts and circumstances of this case, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner/accused.

In the result this petition is allowed subject to following conditions.

- i) The petitioner is ordered to be enlarged on bail on executing his bond for Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties for a like sum each to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate, Sankarankovil.
- ii) The sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the sureties shall produce a copy of their Aadhaar card or Solvency Certificate or Bank pass book to ensure their identity.

- iii) **The petitioner shall stay at Virudhunagar and report and sign before the West P.S, Virudhunagar daily once at 10.00 A.M until further orders.**
- iv) **The Petitioner has to furnish his Mail ID and Phone number before the trial court at the time of executing bond.**
- v) The petitioner shall make available himself for interrogation as and when required by the investigation Officer.
- vi) The petitioner shall not tamper the witness or hamper the evidence in any manner either during investigation or Trial.
- vii) The petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or Trial.
- viii) That on breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the Investigation Officer shall report to the learned Magistrate / Trial Court and shall take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law.
- ix) If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered U/S.269 BNS.
