Petition dated 01.06.2026 U/s.483 BNSS to grant bail to the petitioner.

This petition is coming on this day for hearing before this court in the presence of Thiru.K.P.Kumar Pandian, Advocate for the Petitioner and Thiru.M.P.K.Maruthappan, Public Prosecutor for the Respondent/complainant and upon hearing both sides, this Court passed the following :

ORDER

The Petitioner/accused was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 14.05.2026 for the alleged offences punishable under sections 24(1) of CAOTP Act and section 123 of BNS registered by the respondent police, seeks bail.

The learned Counsel for the petitioners/accused would submit that this petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case by using another case property and this is purely put up case only and this petitioner is no way connected with the occurrence and the property was seized from the godown of this petitioner without any search intimation and this petitioner has no previous case and this petitioner is undergoing incarceration for the past 22 days and prays to grant bail to the petitioner subject to any conditions.

The learned Public Prosecutor would submit that totally 2 accused persons involved in this case and this petitioner being A1 in rank and the allegation against the accused persons is that they were in possession of 1300 kgs of prohibited cool lip tobacco worth about Rs.8,37,000/- and the same was recovered and this petitioner has no previous case and a huge quantity of tobacco product were involved in this case and the investigation is not yet completed and hence it is strongly objected to release the petitioner on bail.

Heard. Records perused. The submissions of both sides were considered. Totally 2 accused persons involved in this case and this petitioner being A1 in rank and the allegation against the accused persons is that they were in possession of 1300 kgs of prohibited cool lip tobacco worth about Rs.8,37,000/-. Eventhough this petitioner is undergoing incarceration for the past 22 days and the property was recovered, considering the fact that a huge quantity of tobacco products were involved in this case and the strong objection submitted by the learned Public Prosecutor and there is no change of circumstances in this case and the attitude and the antecedents of these petitioners and other facts and circumstances, this Court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner/ accused.

In the result this petition is dismissed.
