Petition dated 23.10.2025 U/s. 5 of Limitation Act prays to condone the delay of 246 days in filing Criminal Revision Petition.

This petition is coming on this day for hearing before this court in the presence of Thiru.S.Velpandian, Advocate for the petitioner and Thiru.M.P.K.Maruthappan, Advocate for the 1st respondent and the respondents 2 & 3 are called absent and set exparte and upon hearing petitioner side, this Court passed the following :

ORDER

The Petitioner/Revision petitioner has filed this petition u/s 5 of the Limitation of Act prays to condone the delay of 246 days in filing Criminal Appeal.

The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the learned Judicial Magistrate, Shencottai on 11.11.2024 has passed order in return of property petition

in M.P.No.1/2024 in Cr.M.P.No.1401/2024 by dismissing the petition and due to the petitioner affected by Jauntice, the petitioner was not able to file the Criminal Revision Petition before this court within the stipulated period as prescribed in Act and the delay of 246 days is neither willful nor wanton and hence, prays to condone the delay of 246 days in filing the Criminal Appeal.

The 2nd and 3rd Respondents in this case are called absent and set exparte. 1st respondent also did not give any reply before this court.

Heard both sides. On perusal of records it came to know that the petitioner affected by Jauntice and due to illhealth and undergone treatment, he was not able to file the criminal revision petition before this court within the time and 246 days delay occurred. In the said circumstances, considering the fact that, this petition is allowed on payment of cost of Rs.1,000/- to the mediation center, Tenkasi on or before 16.03.2026 failing which the petition shall stands dismissed. Call on 16.03.2026.
