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**ORDER BELOW EXH.1 IN CRI. BAIL APPLN. NO. 666/2022**

- 1) Perused application, say and case diary. Heard parties.
- 2) The accused is in custody in C. R. No. 496/2022 under Sections 380, 454 and 457 of the Indian Penal Code registered at Bazarpeth police station, Bhusawal, from 05.10.2022. The informant has claimed that several electric motors and other devices worth ₹67,000/- were stolen from his shop in the night of 03.10.2022. Out of that some articles worth ₹26,680/- have been recovered from the accused. The associates of the accused have already been released on bail. There appears no reason to keep him detained as the remaining investigation can be carried out even without his detention. Even the investigating officer has opposed the application mainly on the ground the accused may commit similar offence. This being so, the accused can be granted bail on certain terms and conditions. Hence, the order.

**ORDER**

- 1) Application is allowed.
- 2) Accused Shadab Khan Shakil Khan be released on P.B. and S.B. of ₹15,000 subject to condition that he shall attend Bazarpeth police station, Bhusawal, every day from 7:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. for one month from the next day of his release and thereafter on every Monday during the same time till filing of the charge sheet.
- 3) Accused shall not tamper with prosecution witnesses and evidence in any manner.
- 4) Bail before learned Trial Court.
- 5) Hamdast allowed.
