ORDER

1. The instant petition has been filed by the petitioner under Sec.13(3) of the Registration of Births and Deaths Act seeking direction of the Court to the respondent to register the date of birth of the petitioner's daughter by name Ritee R d/o RAghavenera R and Shilpa G R as on 02/05/2011 in the concerned birth register.
2. The brief facts of the case of the petitioner are as under:

It is the contention of the petitioner that her daughter has been born on 02/05/2011 at Bengaluru. It is pleaded that when the petitioner has approached the respondent for the purpose of getting birth certificate, respondent has not registered date of birth in the concerned register. Therefore, it is required for relevant purposes. Further, the petitioner has filed an application before the respondent for issuing birth extract of her daughter, but the respondent has issued non-availability certificate on 20/05/2022 stating that birth of petitioner's daughter named above is not registered in register of births. Hence, the present petition.

3. Though the notice has been served on the respondent, he has not appeared before the Court, hence he has been placed ex-parte.
4. The petitioner in order to prove her case examined herself as P.W.1 and got marked five documents at Ex.P.1 to Ex.P.5 and closed her side.
5. I have heard the learned Counsel for the petitioner.
6. After the perusal of the case the following points would arise for my consideration:
 - 1) Whether the petitioner is entitled for the relief as sought in the petition?
 - 2) What order?
7. My findings on the above points are as follows:

Point No.1: **In the AFFIRMATIVE.**

8. **Point No.1:** The petitioner in order to prove her case examined herself as P.W.1 and got marked five documents at Ex.P1 to E.P5. P.W.1 in her evidence has stated that her

daughter has been born on 02/05/2011 at Bengaluru. It is pleaded that when she has approached Birth Registrar for the purpose of getting birth certificate, but respondent has not registered date of birth in concerned register. It is further contended that she has not informed the date of birth of her daughter due to un-awareness of the law. Ex.P.1 is the non-availability certificate issued by the respondent wherein it is mentioned that date of birth of petitioner's daughter is not recorded in concerned register. She has also produced notarised copies of three Aadhar cards and transfer certificate and which are marked at Ex.P2 to ExP5. The oral and documentary evidence adduced by petitioner is sufficient to hold that her daughter has born on 02/05/2011. Accordingly, I answer therpoint in the affirmative.

9. Point No.2: In the result, I proceed to pass the following:

ORDER

The petition filed by the petitioner Under Sec. 13(3) of Birth and Death Registration Act, 1969 is hereby allowed.

The respondent is directed to register the date of birth of the petitioner's daughter by name Ritee R d/o RAghavenera R and Shilpa G R as on 02/05/2011 at No.21/1, Emmanuel pearl, Flat No.B-301, 3rd floor, Rest House Road off Brigard road, Bangalore GPO, Bangalore-560001 in the concerned birth register and issue birth certificate after collecting the late fee.
