KAPIL KUMAR BANSAL VS. M/S DOLPHIN FOOTWEAR PVT LTD

Heard. Record perused.

Ld. counsel for JD submits that during the pendency of the execution petition bearing No.206/2025, titled as KAPIL KR. BANSAL VS. DOLPHIN FOOTWEAR PVT. LTD., the warrants of attachment of the bank account of JD were issued as per order dated 20.03.2026, being account No.00960500000024 in the Bank of Baroda, IFSC: BARB0GREATE in the name of M/s. Dolphin Footwear Pvt. Ltd. It is further submitted by both the sides that during pendency of the said execution petition, the matter was amicably settled in mediation proceedings and in compliance with the terms of mediation settlement, the JD had issued 10 PDCs/cheques of the same account as mentioned above to the DH, however, since the said account is still lying freezed, therefore, the said cheques were dishonoured on presentation.

It is jointly prayed by both the sides that the said account may be de-freezed. It is further submitted at bar by both the counsels that there is no obstacle in de-freezing the aforesaid bank account and there is no order of any superior court in this regard.

In view of the above submissions and in the interest of justice, the bank account of JD bearing No.00960500000024 in the Bank of Baroda, IFSC: BARB0GREATE in the name of M/s. Dolphin Footwear Pvt. Ltd. be de-freezed immediately. The Manager concerned is directed to do the needful.

At this stage, it is clarified by both the counsels that the above said cheques were issued from account No.00960200001014 as reflected in order dated 16.04.2026 passed in execution petition No.206/2025. It is prayed by

both the sides that since both the bank accounts of JD were attached in pursuance to the court order, therefore, now both the accounts may be de-freezed as the matter stands settled between the parties.

In view of the above submissions, both the above said accounts of JD be de-freezed. The needful be done as per law.

The application of JD u/s 152 CPC r/w Section 151 CPC stands disposed off accordingly.
