This petition came up before me today for final hearing in the presence of Tr.K.V.Veerapandian B.A.B.L., the Learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr.R.Suresh the learned APP appearing for the respondent and materials available, this court passes the following....

ORDER

1.The petitioner has filed this application under section 480 BNSS for seeking bail for the offence under section U/s. U/s.498(A), 494, 294(b), 109, 506(ii) IPC.

2. The petitioner/accused is in judicial custody for the past 9 days from 19.11.2024. The petitioner/accused has been arrested due to non appearance during trial and subsequently NBW has been issued by this court on 01.11.2021. Now the petitioner has remanded on 19.11.2024 and is being under judicial custody. The petitioner is an ill patient and is taking regular treatment in hospital. Because of which she did not attend the hearing which is neither willful nor wanton. That the petitioner is a law abiding citizen. Therefore, he seeks to release the petitioner on bail.

3. Notice given. Respondent police stated that the accused has not appeared before this court for several years to trial. Hence NBW was issued against her and an execution of NBW on 19.11.2024. If the accused is released on bail she may abscond, she will not come during trial. Hence strongly oppose the release of the accused on bail. The petition may be dismissed.

4. Heard, records carefully perused. The petitioner/accused has been in Judicial custody for the past 9 days from 19.11.2024. Further the petitioner's counsel filed Memo and Medical report of the accused stating that she has been suffering with seizure, hence she has been taking regular treatment in hospital. Considering the facts and circumstances of this case and the period of incarceration and in the interest of Justice this court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner/ accused on following conditions.

Conditions

- 1). The Petitioner/Accused shall execute a bond for sum Rs.10,000/- with two sureties each for a like sum. One surety shall be a blood relative of the petitioner.
- 2) The petitioner/Accused shall not commit any offence in future.
- 3) The Petitioner/Accused shall sign before the Tenkasi, All woman police station daily Morning at 10.00 A.M until further orders.
- 4) The Petitioner/Accused shall appear before the court on all hearings unless she is exempted from appearing by this court.
- 5) The Petitioner/Accused shall appear before respondent police station as and when required for interrogation.

In the result this petition is allowed.
