This petition came up before me today for final hearing in the presence of Tr.M.Gnanaprakasam B.A.,B.L., the Learned counsel for the petitioners and Mr.R.Suresh the learned APP appearing for the respondent and materials available, this court passes the following....

ORDER

The petitioners have filed this application under section 480 BNS seeking bail for the offence under section 191(2), 191(3), 126(2), 296(b), 131, 351(3) BNS Act.

2. The petitioners/accused are in judicial custody for the past 7 days from 15.08.2024. The petitioners/accused are innocent falsely implicated in this case due to enmity. The petitioners/accusedThe petitioners have filed this application under section 480 BNS seeking bail for the offence under se are a man of means, they are prepared to offer sureties for their release on bail. No previous case pending against the accused. The petitioners/accused will not abscond or evade the due process of law. Therefore, he seeks to release the petitioner on bail.

3. Notice given. Respondent police stating that if the accused are released on bail they may abscond and they will not come during trial and they may commit the

similar offence repeatedly in future. Hence strongly oppose to release the accused on bail. Petition may be dismissed.

4. Heard, records carefully perused. The petitioners/accused have been in Judicial custody for the past 7 days from 15.08.2024. Considering facts and circumstances of this case and the period of incarceration and in the interest of Justice this court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioners/ accused on following conditions.

Conditions

- 1). The Petitioners/Accused shall execute a bond for sum Rs.10,000/- with two sureties each for a like sum.
- 2) The petitioners/Accused shall not commit any offence in future.
- 3) The Petitioners/Accused shall sign before the respondent police station daily Morning at 10.00 A.M for 30 days.
- 4) The Petitioners/Accused shall appear before the court on all hearings unless they are exempted from appearing by this court.
- 5) The Petitioners/Accused shall appear before respondent police station as and when required for interrogation.

In the result this petition is allowed.
